- I. **Welcome and Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 12:03 p.m.
- II. **Quorum Validation (5 required):** A quorum was validated.
- III. **Minutes Approval (October 22, 2024)\*:** Minutes were approved as submitted.
- IV. **Directors Report (Ms. Eva Anagnostis, GCWD Asst. Director)**
  - a. **2023-2027 Local and Regional Plans:** Ms. Anagnostis discussed the recent Local and Regional Plans that were updated and submitted to the state. There was a new section that was added this time around. We had input from different board staff, our contracts, and a data consultant. The plan was posted for public comment, but we did not receive any comments. Ms. Anagnostis shared her screen and let committee members know where they could access the plan on our website. We expect to hear feedback from the state for any changes that need to be made. Mr. Forbes asked about any important trends we noticed while we updated the plan. Ms. Anagnostis noted the focus on how technology and workforce intersect, and the high proportion of individuals who have access to high speed internet access in Greenville County compared to the rest of the state. We will share more data trends in the future.
  - b. **PY25 SC Works Greenville MOU/IFA:** Ms. Anagnostis reminded the committee about the PY25 MOU/IFA Negotiation process that will start again in February. WIOA requires all local mandated partners to help share in the infrastructure costs of the SC Works system. A new state instruction notice was issued, and we will be working on updating the documents for the year. We do not anticipate any big changes going into the coming year. Those who are involved in the process will be receiving documents leading up to the February 20<sup>th</sup> meeting.
  - c. **PY25 Adult/DW/Operator/BST Request for Proposals:** Ms. Anagnostis described the WIOA requirement that we put out a Request for Proposal (RFP) at least once every four years to obtain a contract for services. We are currently in the process of accepting proposals for our joint regional contract with the Upstate Workforce Board. Interested parties should go to the

Spartanburg County Purchasing department for more information. We may be reaching out for more help for that process.

**V. Roundtable Updates Discussion (SC Works Partners)**

- Ms. Victoria Novak (Greenville Literacy Association) discussed a recent executive order related to federal grants. She asked how it affects the SC Works system. Ms. Anagnostis shared that we have not received any direct communication from DOL or the state regarding the executive order. Our funding has been appropriated by congress, so we still expect to receive it. If we hear anything different, we will share it with partners. Ms. Novak also shared that GLA is turning 60 years old, and they are doing a celebration luncheon on March 13<sup>th</sup> that will have some great speakers and awards.
- Mr. Weyland Burns (Lifelong Learning) shared some information about how recent executive orders may affect his organization, especially with his English as a Second Language (ESL) students.
