- I. Meeting opened. There was not a quorum (4 voting members minimum). Minutes approval from December 5, 2024 not approved without a quorum. Suggested approval via email. Thank you to Tammy for hosting the meeting.
- II. Updates.
 - a. Vocational Rehabilitation has hired and has a few remaining vacancies for transition counselors (masters) and a vocational evaluator (bachelor's). They serve veterans but many are coming through the VA. ACTION ITEM: link to job postings.
 - b. Barbara Stone Foundation just hired Melissa Sanders for the project manager position vacated by Chris Sparrow. Also seeking Executive Operations Assistant which they will be posting in March. ACTION ITEM: share the posting with the group. Most applicants want to work remotely and seek flex hours.
 - c. Goodwill has a part-time admin position open and seeks someone who is detail-oriented, can handle data systems, and can successfully engage with employers. They have had a lot of new hires to fill vacancies.
- III. New Business.
 - a. BSF is hosting CAN Talks. On March 5th at 6 pm, they will host a general interest meeting for anyone interested in being a potential speaker. It will give a general overview of what CAN Talks is, which runs from April to October. We have 4 to 5 confirmed coaches – pairing one coach to one speaker. Allison is the coaching captain. Speaker and coach guides are provided.
 - b. Discussed leadership in turbulent times. Focusing on serving the people as we have been doing, on finding ways to diversity funding when possible, and on developing contingency plans. Focusing on the most immediate connections and local partnerships.
 - c. Discussed disability sensitivity and etiquette training at Roper Mountain Rd.
